### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Since Thanksgiving is this week, what is one thing that you are grateful for this year?
2. Read Luke 17:11-14. Why were the lepers standing "at a distance"? *Study note for leaders: those who had leprosy in Jewish culture were "unclean" and were not allowed to be a part of most of daily society, not to mention religious life.*
3. Have you ever had an experience where something positive and unexpected happened for you all of the sudden? What was that like?
4. Read Luke 17:15-19. Why do you think nine of the ten lepers did not come back to thank Jesus?
5. Do you relate more to the nine lepers who did *not* come back to thank Jesus, or do you relate more to the one who did?
6. How can we become more like the one leper who came back to thank Jesus?

One of them, when he saw that he was healed, came back to Jesus, shouting, "Praise God!" He fell to the ground at Jesus' feet, thanking him for what he had done.
