- 1. What is the best *unexpected* gift you have ever received?

Study note for leaders: Jonathan had been exceedingly kind to David when Saul Jonathan's father was trying to kill David. Normally when a new king not of the former king's line comes into power, he eliminates every person in the former king's family. What David does is a huge departure from what kings normally did.
- 3. What reason does David give for doing what he did?
- 4. Read 2 Samuel 9:11-13. Why do you think the narrator makes a point of pointing out in verse 13 that Mephibosheth was crippled in both feet?
- 5. In what ways can our relationship with God be compared to Mephibosheth and his situation?
